

Ever since the transit service cuts and fare increases were announced earlier this year, Morris County and NJ Transit have been working together to make the most of our remaining bus system. Service on this modified route system will begin on October 4, 2010. Representatives from NJ Transit Bus Planning have offered to provide representatives from Morris County agencies with a tutorial on the new system. Their presentation will take place on Friday, September 10, 2010 at 10:00 AM at the Morris County Public Safety Academy in Room 139. The session is expected to conclude at approximately 11:30 AM. NJ Transit will make a PowerPoint presentation and hand out materials that you can take back to share with your co-workers.
