



The Morris County Chamber of Commerce partners with an organization named “When Work Works” (WWW). Together we work to support flexible workplaces.

The focus of When Work Works is to:

- . share research and employer best practices on flexibility and workplace effectiveness;
- . inspire change that provides understanding of how flexibility can benefit business and employees;
- . recognize exemplary employers.

The organization sponsors the Alfred B. Sloan Awards which recognizes employers that utilize workplace flexibility to engage their employees, and increase job satisfaction and retention. The Morris County Chamber of Commerce recognizes the winners of the Sloan Awards in October at our Economic Outlook Luncheon.

Employers apply for the Sloan Award on line at www.whenworkworks.org. The application includes an employer questionnaire that takes one hour to complete. This is followed up with a questionnaire to a limited number of employees which takes 20 minutes. Sloan Award recipients in Morris County have included BASF, Solix, One Call Medical and others. These companies have reported that the Sloan Awards process added value for them and they have used their status as Sloan winners to recruit and retain employees.

The Chamber is inviting a limited number of companies to apply for the Sloan Award. We look forward to recognizing a Sloan winner again in the fall of 2010.

The applications deadline for Morris County companies is May 25, 2010.
