### **ISIS expert to speak about how global terrorism impacts local Americans**

**Florham Park, NJ – June 23, 2016** – A renowned international expert on ISIS and global terrorism will explain how this threat impacts everyday Americans when he speaks at a Morris County Chamber of Commerce event Wednesday, June 29, at the Park Savoy in Florham Park.

Peter Krause is a recognized leader on global terrorism and has done leadership briefings at the Pentagon and on Capitol Hill. A dynamic speaker, Krause has appeared on CNN, MSNBC and Fox. He has two forthcoming books, "Rebel Power: Why National Movements Compete, Fight and Win" and "The Power to Hurt: Coercion in Theory and Practice," which he co-authored.

Krause has done extensive work in the Middle East over the last decade and is an assistant professor of political science at Boston College and a research affiliate with the MIT Security Studies Program.
