Pleasant Animal Shelter's mission is to build a community of people and organizations working together to save today's and prevent tomorrow's, abused, neglected, and homeless animals. We do this by Delivering the highest level of animal care to prepare today's animals in need for their future homes, Bringing together the cats and dogs who need a loving family with the people who want them, and Providing community services and resources to ensure every animal has a safe and healthy life

**SERVICES:** For more than 50 years, Mt. Pleasant Animal Shelter (MPAS) has been dedicated to providing exceptional care for homeless cats and dogs, working tirelessly to place them in permanent, loving homes. While MPAS prioritizes saving abandoned animals within our community, our efforts extend far beyond. We partner with public shelters to rescue at-risk animals from euthanasia and ensure no animal is euthanized at MPAS due to time or space constraints. Every adoptable animal remains in our care until they find their forever home. What sets MPAS apart is our commitment to the more than 1,000 animals we shelter annually. Every animal receives vaccinations, spay or neuter surgery, deworming treatments, and a microchip. For those requiring more intensive medical intervention, Nicky's Second Chance Fund enables us to provide lifesaving or restorative care. Our Behavior and Enrichment Program focuses on enhancing the quality of life for shelter animals and ensuring a smooth transition into their new homes. Through individualized training, enrichment activities, canine field trips, and free-roaming catteries, this program reduces stress and boredom, prepares animals for successful adoptions, and shortens their stay in the shelter. MPAS also offers a Foster Care Program, which provides a temporary, loving home environment for animals awaiting adoption. MPAS supplies all necessary items, including food, toys, and medical care, while fosters provide attention and support, helping animals transition more easily into their permanent homes. Additionally, MPAS connects animals with loving families through adoption initiatives, educational workshops, and community events. Together, these programs reflect our unwavering commitment to animal welfare and our vision of a world where every pet has a loving home through our Local Arts Grants program to expand access to quality arts experiences in Morris County.

**AREA:** MPAS prioritizes saving abandoned animals within our community, however our efforts extend far beyond as we work with partner shelters across New Jersey and beyond to save animals at-risk of being euthanized.
